Marsy's Law, Penal Code section 3041.5(a)(4) permits the victim, next of kin, members of the victim's family, and two representatives designated by the victim to request and receive a stenographic record of all proceedings. Any persons requesting a hearing transcript must be registered and meet the criteria of a victim as identified through the Office of Victim and Survivor Rights and Services (OVSRS).

The Board of Parole Hearings (Board) does not charge for electronically produced transcripts sent to a requester's e-mail address. Transcripts processed and mailed by means of United States Postal Service or not electronically available (microfilm or microfiche) will cost 12 cents per page, plus postage, per transcript request. If multiple inmates or hearing dates are requested, the requests must be submitted on separate forms.
