Motion:	The Board finds the inmate would pose an unreasonable risk of danger to the public if released on parole for the reasons stated by the panel member who denied parole at the inmate's June 28, 2013, hearing and, in particular, the inmate's pattern of manipulative behavior as exhibited in the life crime (and first acknowledged by the inmate at that hearing) and supported by the clinician's finding that the inmate exhibits a high propensity for psychopathy and a moderate risk for future violence.
