

**ADDENDUM  
TO THE ADOPTED MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE  
25-BED ACUTE/INTERMEDIATE MENTAL HEALTH CARE FACILITY  
CALIFORNIA INSTITUTION FOR WOMEN**

Pursuant to Sections 15162(a) and (b) and 15164(b) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) has prepared an Addendum to the Adopted Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the 25-Bed Acute/Intermediate Mental Health Care Facility at the California Institute for Women (CIW) because of modifications made to the project, described in the attached Addendum. The modifications do not raise important new issues about the significant impacts on the environment beyond those previously analyzed in the adopted MND. Therefore the CDCR can take action on the projects as being within the scope of the adopted MND.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION**

CIW encompasses approximately 120 acres and is located at 16756 Chino-Corona Road, in the extreme southwest corner of San Bernardino County. The adopted MND evaluated the construction and operation of a single-story 39,810 square-foot facility to provide housing, treatment, and support space for 25 single-occupancy cells. The current modifications are to expand the size of the facility to accommodate 45 single-occupancy cells in a 60,479 square-foot, two-story structure (45-bed facility).

Based on the findings in this Addendum, these modifications do not substantially differ from the project in the adopted MDN. Mitigation measures previously identified for biological and cultural resources would still be applicable under the modified project, and impacts would not be more severe as the project footprint would not change.

The environmental impacts of this project were addressed by the adopted MND for the 25-bed Acute/Intermediate Mental Health Care Facility (25-bed facility) at the CIW dated November 7, 2006, State Clearinghouse Number 2006101010. Specifically, the following resources were reviewed and found to be adequately considered by the MND, as supplemented:

**ANALYSIS**

The proposed project is described in Section 2 of the Addendum to the Adopted Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 25-Bed Acute/Intermediate Mental Health Care Facility, California Institution for Women and the Department's environmental analysis of the environmental effects of the proposed modifications to the project are discussed in Section 3 of the Addendum. The modifications would not alter any of the impact significance conclusions, as reported in the adopted MND when CDCR approved and filed the Notice of Determination on November 7, 2006. Further, no new substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant environmental effects was identified. Approval of the proposed project will not have any significant environmental impacts not previously disclosed in the MND referenced above. Therefore, no further environmental review is required.
