**DEFENDANTS' JUNE 2014 STATUS
REPORT IN RESPONSE TO FEBRUARY
10, 2014 ORDER**

1 The State submits this status report on the current in-state and out-of-state adult prison
2 populations and the measures being taken to reduce the prison population in response to the
3 Court's February 10, 2014 Order Granting in Part and Denying Part Defendants' Request for
4 Extension of December 31, 2013 Deadline (February 10, 2014 Order).

5 Exhibit A sets forth the current design bed capacity, population, and population as a
6 percentage of design bed capacity for each state prison and for all state prisons combined. As of
7 June 11, 2014, 116,485 inmates were housed in the State's 34 adult institutions, which amounts to
8 140.8% of design bed capacity, and 8,611 inmates were housed in out-of-state facilities.¹ The
9 current design bed capacity reported in Exhibit A includes beds at the newly opened DeWitt
10 Nelson Annex at the California Health Care Facility (CHCF), Stockton. Defendants are
11 continuing to work cooperatively with the *Plata* Receiver to resolve issues related to the full
12 activation and operation of CHCF. Defendants will continue to inform the *Plata* and *Coleman*
13 courts on the progress at CHCF using existing reporting measures in each court.

14 Exhibit B sets forth the steps Defendants are taking to implement the measures designed
15 to reduce the prison population detailed in the February 10 order and the status of these measures.
16 (ECF 2766/5060 at ¶¶ 4-5.)
