23rd Annual Operation Boo Offers Ride-Alongs for Media to Sex Offender Enforcement Areas

Halloween night compliance checks to be conducted across the state

What: The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) will conduct the 23rd Annual Operation Boo compliance checks. This year's Halloween child-safety project will feature a parent educational component and visits to sex offender transient curfew centers (where available), in addition to the customary compliance checks and media ride-alongs.
