

Notice of Conditions of Parole

You are being released to parole with the Division of Juvenile Justice. The rules of parole you must follow are ordered by the Juvenile Parole Board. Those rules are called conditions of parole. Your parole agent may give you other rules to follow. These rules are intended to help you to do well on parole. If you have a problem or do not understand the rules, talk to your parole agent. The Division of Juvenile Justice will do its best to help you on parole. You must obey these rules. If you do not, you may be arrested and returned to custody.

Special Conditions of Parole

- A. Your crime was against a person. You must not talk to, visit, call or write the victim(s) or any one in their family unless your parole agent gives you written permission. *(Charge Code 019)*
- B. Your crime was against a person under the age of 18. You must not talk to, visit, call or write any person that you know to be under the age of 18 without permission from your parole agent. *(Charge Code 019)*
- C. You must not drink or have any alcohol. *(Charge Code 011)*
- D. You must take drug tests for illegal drugs, prescription drugs and/or alcohol.

General Conditions of Parole

1. You must do what your parole agent tells you to do. *(Charge Code 024)*
2. You must obey all laws and ordinances. Breaking the law is a parole violation, even if you are not charged or convicted in court. *(Specify code relative to the behavior)*
3. You must not move from your house/placement unless you ask your parole agent and he or she says it is OK before you move. You must go to all scheduled meetings with your parole agent, and you cannot go some place where your parole agent cannot find you. *(Charge Code 022)*
4. You must not leave the State of California unless your parole agent says so in writing before you go, and you are required to return to the State of California when your parole agent tells you to. *(Charge Code 004)*
5. A parole agent, or the police, may search you, your home, your car or your property at any time. They do not need a warrant or probable cause to do this. *(Charge Code 005)*
6. You must not own, possess, use, have under your control or have access to any deadly weapons, firearms (any kind of gun), knives (with blade longer than 2 inches), crossbow, explosive devices, taser or ammunition. *(Charge Codes 034, 037, 038, 043, 044, 046)*
7. You must not own, use, possess or have under your control or have access to any toy or fake weapons, which would make a reasonable person believe that you are in possession of a deadly weapon, firearm, knife, explosive device or ammunition (i.e. toy guns, BB guns, Air Soft guns, plastic guns or knives, etc.). *(Charge Code 041)*
8. You must report all arrests/tickets to your parole agent or another person in the parole office if your parole agent is not there within one business day of such arrest/ticket. *(Charge Code 025)*
9. You must not be in the United States illegally. *(Charge Code 953)*
10. You must show proof of being in or trying to get into school, work or job training. *(Charge Code 006)*
11. You must not own, use, possess, sell, have under your control or access to any controlled substance, dangerous drug, narcotic (including marijuana) or other mind altering substance not prescribed by a licensed doctor. *(Charge Codes 747, 749)*
12. You must not own, use, possess, sell, have under your control or access any drug paraphernalia (i.e. crack pipes, roach clips, bongs, meth pipes, rolling papers, spoons, syringes, etc.). *(Charge Code 750)*
13. You must take drug tests for illegal drugs, prescription drugs and/or alcohol when your parole agent tells you to. *(Charge Code 012)*
14. You must not hang out in areas where you know drug sale activities occur. *(Charge Code 779)*
15. You must pay in full any restitution fine or restitution ordered by the court. You may arrange to pay a little at a time depending on how much money you make. *(as defined by WIC1766.1). (Charge Code 007)*
16. Your parole will be revoked if you do not sign this form agreeing to these rules. *(Charge Code 996)*
