DEFINITIONS

Second Strike: Penal Code Section 667 (b)-(i), specifically (e)(1), indicates a defendant who has **one prior serious or violent felony conviction** that has been pled and proven in court and who is **convicted of any new offense** results in the new term being doubled. Case law permits the prosecutor to look at the underlying factors of the prior offenses when proving the conviction. It does not matter if the new offense is serious or violent as it is the prior serious/violent offense that causes the new term to be doubled. A judge has the ability to dismiss a strike if the action is deemed appropriate. These persons are referred to as Second Strikers. The Legal Status Summaries for these inmates will reflect a “2” by the number of strikes to denote they are Second Strikers in that their term was doubled. These inmates will be released on their Earliest Possible Release Date. These inmates do **not** appear before the Board of Prison Hearings; their release is governed by application of the sentencing laws.

Third Strike: Penal Code Section 667 (b)-(i), specifically (e)(2)(A), states a defendant who has **two or more prior serious or violent felony convictions** pled and proven in court and who is **convicted of any new offense** results in the new term being tripled with a minimum sentence being 25 years. If it is determined by the court pursuant to Section 1170 for the underlying conviction, including any enhancement, the maximum term is Life. A judge has the ability to dismiss a strike if the action is deemed appropriate. These persons are referred to as a Third Striker. The Legal Status Summaries for these inmates will reflect a “3” by the number of strikes to denote they are Third Strikers in that their maximum term is Life and the minimum term is as stated above. These inmates must be found suitable for parole by the Board of Prison Hearings and granted a parole date before they can be released from prison.

Offense: See principal offense.

Principal Offense: The controlling offense designated by the court as the base term, **usually** the offense that keeps the offender in custody the longest period of time. What may be the most serious offense may not be listed as principal offense. The principal offense is used for statistical purposes by CDCR.

County of Commitment: Where the sentence was pronounced by the Court.

Old Formula: In the original Second and Third Strike report, the following hierarchy needed to be considered. If a Third Strike offender is in the institution population, the offender may receive a sentence of death, life without the possibility of parole, or life with the possibility of parole. However, our Second Strike offenders do **not** include offenders who are serving any type of Life sentence.

DEFINITIONS cont.

New Formula: In the new formula, an offender serving any dual Life/Third Strike term will be eliminated from the count. The rationale for the change is to remove those third Strike offenders who would otherwise be considered Lifers based on the original ISL/DSL law passed in 1977. This report represents only offenders whose term was increased based on the Three Strikes Law passed in 1994.

This report reflects the actual Second and Third Strikers and excludes offenders pending revocation and returned to custody for a parole violation.
