

Crisis Line is staffed by active and retired first responders who understand the needs of callers and assess their level of need.

They offer confidential, immediate help through facilitating four core and distinct options:

1. **Residential Care** - when warranted, our partner *Safe Call Now* facilitates treatment and *Serve & Protect* facilitates aftercare.
2. **Chaplain Alliance** – our network of 3200 chaplains are on call across the country, ready to respond by listening and offering resources.
3. **Mental Health Alliance** – our network of trauma therapists and counselors available to help clients resolve emotional wounds.
4. **Alternative Resources** – service dogs, equine therapy, recreational therapy, etc.
5. **Case Management** - follow up and follow through is essential in rehabilitation and restoration of Heroes and their families.

Why is this service needed?

The challenge of Criminal Justice and Emergency Services often destroys families and takes lives. Anxiety in the job causes depression, addictions, divorce, and sadly, suicide.

Every 17 hours a law enforcement officer commits suicide.

75% of officers have been divorced.

40% of first responders are involved in domestic violence

85% of first responders experience PTSD symptoms
