The purpose of this document is to provide all department staff with information regarding the attached amendment to Chapter 8, Article 47, Charge Codes.

This Notice of Change to Department Operations Manual (DOM) is part of a series of anticipated DOM revisions related to the Board of Parole Hearing's (BPH) changed role in parole violations per current statute. In 2011, the Governor signed Assembly Bill 109, Budget Act of 2011: Public Safety Realignment into law, which made significant changes to the parole revocation process. BPH requested CDCR update multiple DOM policies to reflect BPH's revised responsibilities, and to make additional updates and clarifications in reference to BPH as needed.

As a result of the Public Safety Realignment, the parole authority for the revocation and warrant process shifted from BPH to the superior courts within each of the 58 counties. To track parole violations, the Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO) established the Parole Violation Disposition Tacking System (PVDTS). This article is revised to delete obsolete BPH parole violation charge codes, and replace them with PVDTS charge codes. Technical and law violations are added or removed in accordance with current statute, and the list is provided in numerical order based on the PVDTS charge code rather than grouping and listing violations by category. The title of the article is revised to delete the reference to BPH as these parole violations are no longer under their jurisdiction and position names and organization titles are updated as necessary.
