North Kern and Kern Valley State Prison

Delano, founded in 1873, is the second largest city in Kern County next to Bakersfield. It was once a little railroad town, but became a major agriculture hub for farmers in the 1950's. Today is known for its table grape agriculture. Delano is an base camp for the outdoor adventurer, with access to skiing, kayaking, hiking, golfing and off-road activities. With six parks a soccer field and lake, there is plenty of recreation available.

Local Living

Residents have access to various modes of transportation via public transit, airport and Amtrack. The cost of living is 27% lower than the California average, and the average gross rent is at \$771. Home values estimate at around \$139,000.


