

**Day Reporting Centers (DRC) & Community-Based Coalition (CBC):** DRC's and CBC's are "One Stop Shops" that address a parolee's needs through assessment and placement in designated classes and supportive services. Program components include individual and group counseling, transitional/sober living housing, HIV/sexually transmitted disease awareness, substance abuse education, anger management, domestic violence, cognitive and life skills training, parenting and family reintegration, education/GED preparation, budgeting and money management, job readiness and job search, and referral services. Transitional housing is available to parolees who participate in the DRC/CBC. \*Some DRC's have Caltrans work crews attached to them, where parolees can earn \$10 per hour, 40 hours a week, performing litter abatement.

A 52-week certified domestic violence program is available. Parolees are expected to remain in the program and save 75% of their net earnings once they become employed.

## GLOSSARY

**Day Reporting Centers (DRC) & Community-Based Coalition (CBC):** DRC's and CBC's are "One Stop Shops" that address a parolee's needs through assessment and placement in designated classes and supportive services. Program components include individual and group counseling, transitional/sober living housing, HIV/sexually transmitted disease awareness, substance abuse education, anger management, domestic violence, cognitive and life skills training, parenting and family reintegration, education/GED preparation, budgeting and money management, job readiness and job search, and referral services. Transitional housing is available to parolees who participate in the DRC/CBC. \*Some DRC's have Caltrans work crews attached to them, where parolees can earn \$10 per hour, 40 hours a week, performing litter abatement.

**Computer Literacy Learning Center Program (CLLC):** Located in parole offices, the CLLC (or Literacy Lab) is a computer-assisted instructional program designed to increase the literacy skills of parolees, resulting in increased employability and parolee success. Teachers provide classroom instruction which focuses on basic proficiency in reading, writing and math skills. Students are placed in the CLLC according to their ability and proceed at their own pace, receiving training in life skills and employment competency, with a progression toward earning their GED.

**Golden State Works Initiative Employment Services (GSW):** The GSW will provide transitional employment, job placement and supportive services to recent parolees with the goal of achieving job placement and retention. Services to parolee participants will include life skills education (LSE), employment preparation, transitional employment, permanent job placement and appropriate case management and retention services. This Program allows parolees to work on Caltrans work crews, earning \$10 per hour, 40 hours per week.

**Parolee Service Center (PSC):** The PSC provides housing, support services, life skills training and job preparation to help parolees obtain and maintain a job while in the PSC and after their return to the community. PSCs offer cognitive and life skills training, group and family reunification counseling, anger and stress management, victim awareness, computer operations, money management, job readiness, interview skills, job search and employment, and community reentry planning. A 52-week certified domestic violence program is available. Parolees are expected to remain in the program and save 75% of their net earnings once they become employed.

**Residential Multi-Service Centers (RMSC):** The RMSCs are certified substance abuse treatment facilities, licensed by the Department of Healthcare Services, that provide housing, substance abuse services and independent living skills to at-risk parolees. Services include individual and group counseling, anger management, literacy training and GED preparation, AIDS/HIV education, job preparation and placement, budgeting and money management, and parenting skills training.

**Substance Abuse Treatment and Recovery Program (STAR):** Located in parole offices, STAR is a cognitive behavioral program that provides substance abuse and relapse prevention to parolees in need of substance abuse education.
