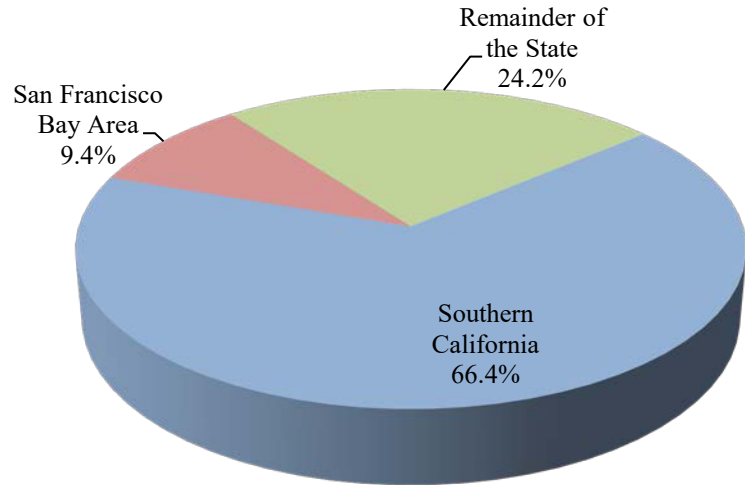
# CHARACTERISTICS OF FELON NEW ADMISSIONS AND PAROLE VIOLATORS RETURNED WITH A NEW TERM (PV-WNTs)

## TOTAL FELON ADMISSIONS

The total felon admission for calendar year 2012 was 33,990.

- The total felon admission population includes:
  - 26,280 felon new admissions.
  - 7,710 felon PV-WNTs
- The number of male felon new admissions decreased from 32,214 in 2011 to 24,384 in 2012. The number of female felon new admissions decreased from 4,182 in 2011 to 1,896 in 2012.
- The number of male PV-WNTs decreased from 13,304 in 2011 to 7,426 in 2012. The number of female felon PV-WNTs decreased from 978 in 2011 to 284 in 2012.

## AREA OF COMMITMENT

During calendar year 2012:

- 22,559 (66.4%) of the total felon admissions were from Southern California.
- 3,210 (9.4%) were from the San Francisco Bay Area.
- 8,221 (24.2%) of the total felon admissions were admitted from the remainder of the state.

## **DEFINITIONS**

**New Admission:** The first commitment from court.

**Parole Violator Returned With a New Term (PV-WNT):** A parolee who has received a court sentence for a new crime and been returned to prison.

**Age:** The age of the offender at the time of admission.

### **NOTE:**

1. The total admissions are based on the number of inmates received from court, who enter a CDCR adult institution during a calendar year.
2. Based upon a felon's first status, only new admissions and parole violators returned with a new term (PV-WNT) are included. Parolees, who return to CDCR with a return status of PRTC or PENDREV and, while in prison, have their return status changed to PV-WNT, are excluded.
3. Inmates who were received by CDCR and released to parole on the same day (paper moves) are not included.
4. Civil Narcotic Addicts, County Diagnostic Cases (under Penal Code Section 1203.09), some Youth Authority commitments, federal prisoners and prisoners from other states are excluded.
