24th Annual Operation Boo Offers Media Ride-Alongs to Sex Offender Enforcement Areas

Halloween night compliance checks to be conducted across the state

What: The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) will conduct the 24th Annual Operation Boo compliance checks and visits to transient sex offender curfew centers (where available) on Halloween evening, offering ride-alongs to media across the state. In addition, this year's child-safety project will once again feature a parent educational component that will be launched one week before Halloween.
