## **Please join OYCR Listening Sessions to Provide Your Input on Project and Grant Priorities**

On July 1, 2021, the Office of Youth & Community Restoration (OYCR) was created pursuant to SB 823, which initiated the final stage of youth justice realignment. Recognizing that youth who have committed law violations, even serious offenses, are better cared for in their own communities, with access to their families, networks, cultural activities, and reentry supports, SB 823 closed California's youth prisons and entrusted the care of all youth who have committed criminal law violations to local jurisdictions.

The mission of OYCR is to “promote trauma responsive, culturally informed services for youth involved in the juvenile justice system that support the youths’ successful transition into adulthood and help them become responsible, thriving, and engaged members of their communities.” (WIC 2200(b).) OYCR also received funding, including \$20 million in 2021-22, to provide technical assistance, disseminate best practices, and issue grants to counties and probation departments for the purpose of transforming the juvenile justice system to improve outcomes for justice involved youth.

OYCR is seeking public input in writing and through listening sessions, on the use of these funds. OYCR is particularly interested in ideas for projects or grants that advance its mission in providing:

- (A) Mental health, sex abuse offense treatment, or related behavioral or trauma-based needs.
- (B) Support programs or services that promote healthy adolescent development.
- (C) Family engagement in programs.
- (D) Reentry, including planning and linkages to support employment, housing, and continuing education.
- (E) Evidence-based, promising, trauma-informed, and culturally responsive care.

All input is welcome and encouraged.
