- III. **2:15 PM California Crisis Care Continuum:** The California Health and Human Services Agency (CalHHS) is developing a Crisis Care Continuum Plan (CCC-P) to support connections among prevention efforts like warmlines and peer support services, 9-8-8 suicide and crisis call centers, mobile crisis response, and community-based crisis care at the local level. The CCC-P is being created with input from diverse stakeholders including, but not limited to, state departments, local jurisdictions, providers, consumers, caregivers, and family members, with a particular focus on individuals from underserved communities, communities of color, LGBTQ+, and youth. An integral part of this effort is to strengthen the continuum of community-based care for Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are experiencing a mental health or substance use disorder crisis. Accordingly, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) submitted a State Plan Amendment to add
