**NOTE:** SB 143, signed by the Governor on September 13, 2023, immediately amended Section 11133 to the Government Code and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2023. The amendment to Section 11133 reinstates Section 11133 that was in effect until July 1, 2023, through Executive Order. SB 143 suspends specific requirements for meetings by teleconference allowing a state body to hold a meeting through teleconferencing wherein members of the public may observe and address the meeting electronically, consistent with the notice and accessibility requirements in subdivisions (d) and (e) of Section 11133, without having to make available any physical location from which members of the public may observe the meeting and offer public comment.

Depending on the number of individuals wishing to address the Council, the Executive Officer and/or Chair may establish specific time limits on presentations.

**\*\*NOTICE\*\***

**Public Participation:** The telephone lines and computer audio systems of members of the public who remote into the meeting will initially be muted to prevent background noise from inadvertently disrupting the meeting. Phone lines and computer audio systems will be unmuted during all portions of the meeting that are appropriate for public comment to allow members of the public to comment. Please see additional instructions below regarding Public Participation Procedures.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCEDURES:** All members of the public shall have the right to offer comment at this public meeting. The Executive Officer will indicate when a portion of the meeting is to be open for public comment and reserves the right to limit the time for comment. Members of the public should be prepared to complete their comments within 2 minutes or less (if a different time allotment is needed), which will be announced by the Chair. Comments must pertain to the agenda item under discussion. Any member of the public wishing to comment during public comment periods must do the following:

- For those attending the meeting in-person, comment cards are available for questions to be submitted to CCJBH staff. When it is your turn to comment, you will be asked to stand at the podium to provide your public comment. Given time constraints, it is not guaranteed that all who request to speak can be accommodated. CCJBH will allow the first 5 requests for comments received to speak. Individuals following these speakers are asked to state only their opposition or support for the agenda item being discussed.
- For those attending virtually, please use the “raise hand” feature to make a comment. You will be placed in line to comment in the order in which requests are received. When it is your turn to comment, the meeting host will unmute your line and announce your name.
- CCJBH encourages groups of people who have a shared position to appoint one or more spokesperson(s) to speak for their group.
- Members of the public should be prepared to complete their comments within 2 minutes or less if a different time allotment is needed and announced by the Executive Officer.

CCJBH, and any committees thereof, comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act by ensuring meeting facilities are accessible to persons with disabilities, and providing that this notice and information given to the Members of the Council is available to the public in appropriate alternative formats, when requested.
