AUDIT

STANDARD

CPOST shall conduct audits to ensure compliance with relevant regulatory requirements, operational procedures, and CPOST training standards. CPOST shall report deficiencies to departmental stakeholders.

COMPONENTS

The components of this standard are as follows:

1. CPOST developed the Apprenticeship Coordinator's Office (ACO) to oversee the daily operations, including annual audits at the institution level to ensure compliance with Apprenticeship Program standards.
2. CPOST audit processes are based on CPOST standards and established operational procedures.

BACKGROUND

The Commission on Correctional Peace Officer Standards and Training (CPOST) elevates Department training by establishing statewide correctional training standards and facilitates the statewide Apprenticeship Program. CPOST uses a collaborative process to develop, establish and monitor appropriate training standards by conducting audit and site visits. CPOST has a formalized process to ensure training, delivery and compliance are aligned with established regulatory standards.
