

# APPENDIX 1 - CDCR ADULT INSTITUTIONS

## ADULT INSTITUTIONS

### *Avenal State Prison (ASP)*



ASP is located in Avenal and was opened in 1987. ASP is situated on 639 acres with 1,670,880 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,424 incarcerated individuals that includes 100 cell beds and 2,324 dorm beds. ASP is designated as a level II institution. Programs include academic/career technical education programs, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

### *Calipatria State Prison (CAL)*



CAL is located in Calipatria and was opened in 1992. CAL is situated on 1,198 acres with 1,157,873 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,808 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,600 cell beds and 208 dorms beds. CAL operates a Water Treatment Plant (WTP). CAL is designated as a level I and IV institution. Programs include academic/career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated Facility C in January 2025.

### *California Correctional Institution (CCI)*



CCI is located in Tehachapi and opened for male incarcerated individuals in 1954. CCI is located on the grounds of the first California women's prison that opened in 1933. CCI is situated on 1,680 acres with 1,558,393 square feet of buildings. The level I facility closed in September 2021. The institution has a design capacity of 1,508 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,500 cell beds and 8 dorms beds. CCI operates a WTP and a Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). CCI is designated as a level II, III, and IV institution. Programs include academic/ career technical education, rehabilitative/ reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated Facility D in June 2023.

## ***California Health Care Facility (CHCF)***



CHCF is located in Stockton and opened in 2013. CHCF is situated on 248 acres with 1,513,000 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,953 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,845 cell beds and 1,108 dorms beds. CHCF is designated as a level II institution. Programs include academic/career technical education and self-help groups and programs.

## ***California Institution for Men (CIM)***



CIM is located in Chino and was opened in 1941. CIM is situated on 1,499 acres with 1,398,611 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,200 incarcerated individuals that includes 954 cell beds and 1,246 dorms beds. CIM is designated as a level I and II institution. Programs include academic/career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated Facility D in April 2023.

## ***California Institution for Women (CIW)***



CIW is located near Chino and was opened in 1952. CIW is situated on 115 acres with 601,596 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,281 incarcerated individuals that includes 164 cell beds and 1,117 dorms beds, including incarcerated individuals in 2 female conservation camps. Programs include academic and career technical education rehabilitative/reentry, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***California Men's Colony (CMC)***



CMC is located in San Luis Obispo and was opened in 1961. CMC is situated on 178 acres with 1,421,718 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,613 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,403 cell beds and 210 dorms beds, including 1 conservation camp. CMC operates a WTP and a WWTP. CMC is designated as a level I, II, and III institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated the West Facility in November 2023.

## ***California Medical Facility (CMF)***



CMF is located in Vacaville and was opened in 1955. CMF is situated on 371 acres with 874,378 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,316 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,505 cell beds and 811 dorms beds. CMF is designated as a level II and III institution. Programs include academic and career technical education and rehabilitative/reentry programs.

## ***Centinela State Prison (CEN)***



CEN is located in Imperial and was opened in 1993. CEN is situated on 1,954 acres with 1,158,274 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,308 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,100 cell beds and 208 dorms beds. CEN operates a WTP and a WWTP. CEN is designated as a level I, III, and IV institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## **California State Prison, Corcoran (COR)**



COR is located in Corcoran and was opened in 1988. COR is situated on 515 acres with 1,760,224 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 3,114 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,622 cell beds and 492 dorms beds. COR operates a WWTP. COR is designated as a level I, II, III, IV, and Restricted Housing Unit (RHU) institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## **California State Prison, Los Angeles County (LAC)**



LAC is located in Lancaster and was opened in 1993. LAC is situated on 262 acres with 1,229,337 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,300 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,100 cell beds and 200 dorms beds. LAC is designated as a level I, III, and IV institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## **California State Prison, Sacramento (SAC)**



SAC is located in Folsom and was opened in 1986. SAC is situated on 118 acres with 1,337,271 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,828 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,636 cell beds and 192 dorms beds. SAC is designated as a level I, II, IV, and RHU institution. Programs include academic and career technical education programs, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***California State Prison, Solano (SOL)***



SOL is located in Vacaville and was opened in 1984. SOL is situated on 546 acres with 1,271,322 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,904 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,184 cell beds and 720 dorms beds. SOL operates a WTP. SOL is designated as a level II and III institution. Programs include academic and career technical education and self-help groups and programs.

## ***Central California Women's Facility (CCWF)***



CCWF is located in Chowchilla and was opened in 1990. CCWF is situated on 662 acres with 864,468 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,986 incarcerated individuals that includes 200 cell beds and 1,786 dorms beds, and is both a reception institution and the housing location for female condemned incarcerated individuals. CCWF operates a WTP and a WWTP. Female offender programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***Correctional Training Facility (CTF)***



CTF is located in Soledad and was opened in 1946. CTF is situated on 633 acres with 1,458,166 square feet of buildings. The level I facility closed in September 2021. The institution has a design capacity of 2,800 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,594 cell beds and 206 dorms beds. CTF is designated as a level II institution. Programs include academic and career technical education programs, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

### ***Folsom State Prison (FSP)***



FSP is located in Folsom and was opened in 1880. FSP is situated on 1,053 acres with 1,121,481 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,065 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,800 cell beds and 265 dorms beds. FWF was deactivated in January 2023. FSP operates a WTP. FSP is designated as a level I, II, and III institution for male incarcerated individuals. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

### ***High Desert State Prison (HDSP)***



HDSP is located in Susanville and was opened in 1995. HDSP is situated on 655 acres with 1,230,785 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,081 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,868 cell beds and 213 dorms beds. HDSP operates a WTP. HDSP is designated as a level I, II, III, and IV institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated Buildings C2 and C8 in Facility C and Buildings D3 and D4 in Facility D in January 2025.

### ***Ironwood State Prison (ISP)***



ISP is located in Blythe and was opened in 1994. ISP is situated on 640 acres with 1,125,271 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,208 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,000 cell beds and 208 dorms beds. ISP is designated as a level I and II institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

### ***Kern Valley State Prison (KVSP)***



KVSP is located in Delano and was opened in 2005. KVSP is situated on 670 acres with 1,441,786 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,448 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,248 cell beds and 200 dorms beds. KVSP operates a WTP and a WWTP. KVSP is designated as a level I and IV institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

### ***Mule Creek State Prison (MCSP)***



MCSP is located in Lone and was opened in 1987. MCSP is situated on 868 acres with 1,640,639 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 3,284 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,500 cell beds and 1,784 dorms beds. MCSP operates a WWTP. MCSP is designated as a level I, II, III, and IV institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

### ***North Kern State Prison (NKSP)***



NKSP is located in Delano and was opened in 1993. NKSP is situated on 636 acres with 922,063 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,910 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,700 cell beds and 210 dorms beds. NKSP is designated as a level I, III, and reception institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated Facility C in January 2025.

### ***Pelican Bay State Prison (PBSP)***



PBSP is located in Crescent City and was opened in 1989. PBSP is situated on 455 acres with 1,219,660 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,804 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,604 cell beds and 200 dorms beds. PBSP operates a WWTP. PBSP is designated as a level I, II, IV, and RHU institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated Facility C in October 2023.

### ***Pleasant Valley State Prison (PVSP)***



PVSP is located in Coalinga and was opened in 1994. PVSP is situated on 333 acres with 1,172,052 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,308 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,100 cell beds and 208 dorms beds. PVSP operates a WWTP. PVSP is designated as a level I, II, and III institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

### ***Richard J. Donovan Correctional Facility (RJD)***



RJD is located in San Diego and was opened in 1987. RJD is situated on 774 acres with 1,611,310 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,992 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,000 cell beds and 992 dorms beds. RJD is designated as a level I, II, and III institution. Programs include academic and career technical education and self-help groups and programs.

## ***Substance Abuse Treatment Facility and State Prison (SATF)***



SATF is located in Corcoran and was opened in 1997. SATF is situated on 810 acres with 1,693,044 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 3,424 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,612 cell beds and 1,812 dorms beds. SATF is designated as a level II, III, and IV institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***Sierra Conservation Center (SCC)***



SCC is located in Jamestown and was opened in 1965. SCC is situated on 444 acres with 697,986 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 4,592 incarcerated individuals that includes 500 cell beds and 4,092 dorms beds, including incarcerated individuals in 31 conservation camps. SCC operates a WTP and a WWTP. SCC is designated as a level I, II, and III institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***San Quentin Rehabilitation Center (SQRC)***



SQRC is located in San Quentin and was opened in 1852. SQRC is situated on 488 acres with 1,623,250 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 3,084 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,569 cell beds and 515 dorms beds. SQRC is designated as a level II institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***Salinas Valley State Prison (SVSP)***



SVSP is located in Soledad and was opened in 1996. SVSP is situated on 337 acres with 1,322,596 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,452 incarcerated individuals that includes 2,252 cell beds and 200 dorms beds. SVSP operates a WTP. SVSP is designated as a level I, III, and IV institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***Valley State Prison (VSP)***



VSP is located in Chowchilla and was opened in 1995. While originally activated as a female prison, it was converted to a male prison in 2013. VSP is situated on 662 acres with 796,490 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 1,961 incarcerated individuals that includes 188 cell beds and 1,773 dorms beds. VSP is designated as a level II institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs.

## ***Wasco State Prison (WSP)***



WSP is located in Wasco and was opened in 1991. WSP is situated on 774 acres with 982,547 square feet of buildings. The institution has a design capacity of 2,384 incarcerated individuals that includes 1,100 cell beds and 1,284 dorms beds. WSP operates a WTP and a WWTP. WSP is designated as a level I, III, and reception institution. Programs include academic and career technical education, rehabilitative/reentry programs, and self-help groups and programs. CDCR deactivated Facility B in January 2025.
