REPORTS AND PRESENTATIONS

Report from Executive Officer, Rachel Stern

STERN welcomed the Commissioners, DJJ staff and community members to the public meeting.

STERN shared the Board has received 45 Honorable Discharge applicants that meet the preliminary requirements of SB 625. The applicants come from 19 different counties. The Board has received 9 summary probation reports. STERN stated that the Board has only received 3 personal statements from former youth and that there is one potential applicant with a complete packet ready to be considered for Honorable Discharge.

STERN stated that all 3 Commissioners were unanimously confirmed by Senate Rules Committee on May 16, 2018. The next step is confirmation by the entire Senate. STERN congratulated the Commissioners.

STERN shared that she and Commissioner BOWENS met with CPOC to update them on the Honorable Discharge process. The focus was increasing communication between DJJ and County Probation to further strengthen the bond with outside stakeholders. STERN discussed the various summary probation reports, noting the thoroughness of Sonoma County.
