



## Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation NOTICE OF TELECONFERENCE PUBLIC HEARING

This notice announces a teleconference public hearing regarding the following proposed adoption of the California Code of Regulations, Title 15, Crime Prevention and Corrections, Division 3, Chapter 1. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and public health emergency, CDCR will be utilizing teleconference for its hearings, consistent with the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 and guidelines issued by the Department of Public Health.
