

### Title 15. Crime Prevention and Corrections

#### Division 3. Adult Institutions, Programs and Parole

#### Chapter 1. Rules and Regulations of Adult Operations and Programs

#### Article 1. Behavior

##### 3000. Definitions.

**[Section 3000 is amended to alphabetically merge the definition below with existing definitions in this section, and is amended to read:]**

Work Change Area means a portal controlled by staff and/or locking gates that is used to control access and includes the area where staff search incarcerated persons prior to permitting incarcerated persons in or out of adjacent areas such as ~~Prison Industry~~ California Correctional Training and Rehabilitation Authority yards.

Rptr. 2d 679; *Madrid v. Cate* (USDC ND Cal. C90-3094 TEH); *Sassman v. Brown* (E.D. Cal. 2015) 99 F.Supp.3d 1223; *Mitchell v. Cate*, USDC ED 2:08-CV-01196-TLN-EFB; *In re Garcia* (2012) 202 Cal.App.4th 892; and *Quine v. #### Article 3. Work and Education

##### 3041.2. Incarcerated Person Pay Rates, Schedule and Exceptions.

**[Subsections 3041.2(a) through (a)(3) are unchanged.]**

**[Subsection 3041.2(b) is amended to read:]**

(b) Exceptions to the above schedules may be made in extraordinary circumstances. A wage comparable to that paid to incarcerated persons in the ~~Prison Industry~~ California

Correctional Training and Rehabilitation Authority incarcerated person pay program may be paid for special projects or assignments that require a high degree of skill or expertise. Other exceptions may also be made in order to fill positions when recruitment or retention of incarcerated workers is a problem. Any exceptions based upon this subsection shall require approval, review and justification on an annual basis by the institution head and Director of Division of Adult Institutions or designees.

## **Subchapter 5.1 Incarcerated and Supervised Person Programs**

### **Article 1. Administrative Remedies**

#### **3480. Implementation Date and Definitions.**

**[Subsections 3480(a) through (b)(5) are unchanged.]**

**[Subsection 3480(b)(6) is amended to read:]**

(6) "Department" and "departmental staff" refers exclusively to the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and to all employees, contractors, and volunteers associated with the department, except those employed by the Board of Parole Hearings, the ~~Prison Industry~~ California Correctional Training and Rehabilitation Authority, and the Commission on Correctional Peace Officer Standards and Training.

**[Subsections 3480(b)(7) through (b)(13) are unchanged.]**

#### **3481. Claimant's Ability to Submit Grievances, Reasonable Accommodation Requests, and Appeals.**

**[Subsections 3481(a) through (d) are unchanged.]**

**[Subsection 3481(e) is amended to read:]**

(e) A claimant does not have the right to grieve or appeal a policy, decision, action, condition, or omission that was not made by the department or departmental staff, but instead was made by an entity or official outside of the department, including, but not limited to, a county jail, the Department of State Hospitals, or the Interstate Commission for Adult Offender Supervision; nor by an entity or official that is quasi-independent of the department, including, but not limited to, the Board of Parole Hearings, the ~~Prison Industry~~ California Correctional Training and Rehabilitation Authority, or the Commission on Correctional Peace Officer Standards and Training. This Article does not preclude a claimant from filing a complaint with the outside entity or official.
