TOTAL FELON ADMISSIONS

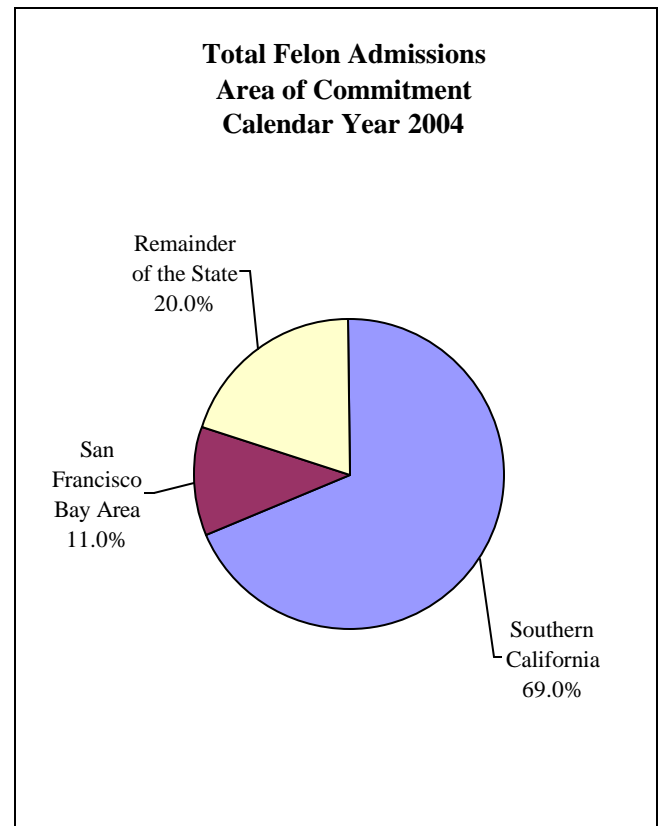
The total felon admission for calendar year 2004 was **64,640**.

- The total felon admission population includes:
 - 46,798 felon new admissions.
 - 17,842 felon PV-WNTs
- During calendar year 2004, the number of male felon new admissions was 41,031 and the number of female felon new admissions was 5,767.
- During calendar year 2004, the number of male PV-WNTs was 16,310 and the number of female felon PV-WNTs was 1,532.

AREA OF COMMITMENT

During calendar year 2004:

- 44,617 (69.0%) of the total felon admissions were from Southern California.
- 7,121 (11.0%) were from the San Francisco Bay Area.
- 12,902 (20.0%) of the total felon admissions were admitted from the remainder of the state.

DEFINITIONS

Felon New Admission: The first commitment from court for a felon.

Parole Violator Returned With a New Term (PV-WNT): A parolee who has received a court sentence for a new crime and been returned to prison.

Principal Offense: The controlling offense designated by the court as the base term, usually the offense that keeps the offender in custody the longest period of time.

First Status: The status, new admission or PV-WNT, at the time an offender enters a CDC institution.

Age: The age of the offender at the time of admission.

NOTE:

1. The total admissions are based on the number of inmates received from court, who enter a CDC institution during a calendar year.
2. Based upon a felon's first status, only new admissions and parole violators returned with a new term (PV-WNT) are included. Parolees, who return to CDC with a return status of PRTC or PENDREV and, while in prison, have their return status changed to PV-WNT, are excluded.
3. Inmates who were received by CDC and released to parole on the same day (paper moves) are not included.
4. Civil Narcotic Addicts, County Diagnostic Cases (under Penal Code Section 1203.09), some Youth Authority commitments, federal prisoners and prisoners from other states are excluded.
