CHARACTERISTICS OF FELON NEW ADMISSIONS AND PAROLE VIOLATORS RETURNED WITH A NEW TERM (PV-WNTs)

TOTAL FELON ADMISSIONS

The total felon admission for calendar year 2010 was 58,743.

- The total felon admission population includes:

41,550 felon new admissions.

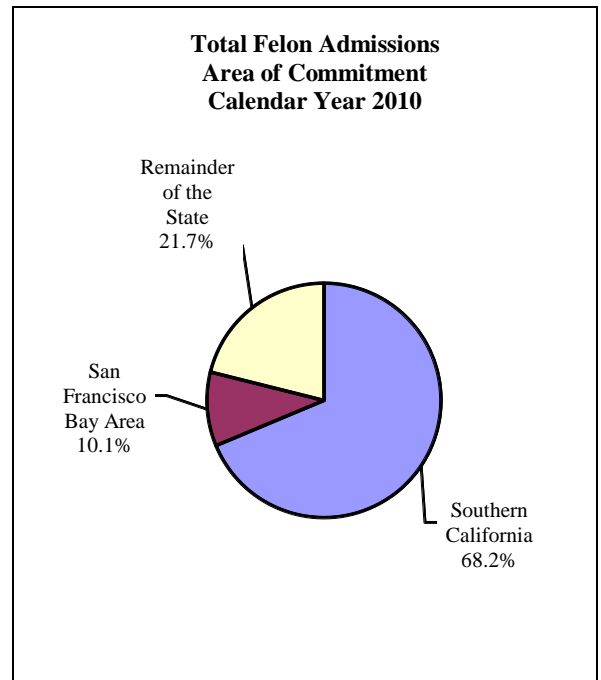
17,193 felon PV-WNTs

- The number of male felon new admissions decreased from 39,466 in 2009 to 36,201 in 2010. The number of female felon new admissions decreased from 5,540 in 2009 to 5,343 in 2010.
- The number of male PV-WNTs decreased from 17,050 in 2009 to 15,763 in 2010. The number of female felon PV-WNTs decreased from 1,577 in 2009 to 1,430 in 2010.

AREA OF COMMITMENT

During calendar year 2010:

- 40,060 (68.2%) of the total felon admissions were from Southern California.
- 5,956 (10.1%) were from the San Francisco Bay Area.
- 12,727 (21.7%) of the total felon admissions were admitted from the remainder of the state.

DEFINITIONS

Felon New Admission: The first commitment from court for a felon.

Parole Violator Returned With a New Term (PV-WNT): A parolee who has received a court sentence for a new crime and been returned to prison.

Principal Offense: The controlling offense designated by the court as the base term, usually the offense that keeps the offender in custody the longest period of time.

First Status: The status, new admission or PV-WNT, at the time an offender enters a CDCR adult institution.

Age: The age of the offender at the time of admission.

NOTE:

1. The total admissions are based on the number of inmates received from court, who enter a CDCR adult institution during a calendar year.
2. Based upon a felon's first status, only new admissions and parole violators returned with a new term (PV-WNT) are included. Parolees, who return to CDCR with a return status of PRTC or PENDREV and, while in prison, have their return status changed to PV-WNT, are excluded.
3. Inmates who were received by CDCR and released to parole on the same day (paper moves) are not included.
4. Civil Narcotic Addicts, County Diagnostic Cases (under Penal Code Section 1203.09), some Youth Authority commitments, federal prisoners and prisoners from other states are excluded.
